ORDER

WHEREAS, on February 26, 2015, the Court approved a Stipulation and Order (the “February 2015 Order”) to govern the conduct of the 2016 International Union delegate and officer election (the “2016 IBT Election”);

WHEREAS, Paragraph four of the February 2015 Order provides that the Government and the International Brotherhood of Teamsters (“IBT”) (collectively, the “Parties”) would jointly agree upon election rules to govern the 2016 IBT Election following comments by IBT members and any interested parties, and would submit the agreed-upon rules to the Court for its consideration and approval;

WHEREAS, the Parties have received and considered comments by IBT members and interested parties regarding the rules to govern the 2016 IBT Election;

WHEREAS, the Parties have now agreed upon rules to govern the 2016 IBT Election (the “Proposed 2016 Election Rules”);


WHEREAS, the Parties have submitted the Proposed 2016 Election Rules to the Court for its consideration and approval; and

WHEREAS, the Court has reviewed the Proposed 2016 Election Rules and finds that approval and enforcement of those Rules will further the objectives of the March 14, 1989 Consent Decree and the Final Order entered on February 17, 2015;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Proposed 2016 Election Rules, a copy of which is annexed hereto, are approved and shall govern the 2016 Election unless modified in accordance with the February 2015 Order.
